

# Dental Hygienists What to Bring Checklist 2017 Pueblo COMOM

## **Be sure personal instruments and supplies are marked with your identification.**

- Container to store and transport instruments  
Consider bringing a plastic container with a lid, fishing tackle box, or a plastic multi-drawer wheeled unit.
- Comfortable clothing (e.g., shorts, scrubs) and supportive, closed-toed shoes.
- Ultrasonic units and tips  
Units and tips will be available. Bring if you would prefer using your own items.
- Dental floss for use in patient procedures
- Large hand-held mirror for patients
- Headlight and extra battery  
This would be an adjunct to a freestanding halogen light beside each chair.
- Loupes and/or operator safety glasses
- Hygiene stools  
A limited number of portable stools will be available but COMOM strongly encourages you to bring your own for maximum comfort.
- Pens with **blue** or ink for charting
- Personal equipment/supplies that you are accustomed to using and will ease your COMOM experience
